Outreach Policy

The John Stahl Library is proud to offer the delivery service of library materials to homebound citizens living within the city of West Point, NE. Residents of West Point health care facilities, assisted living apartments as well as homebound individuals in their own residences are eligible to receive Outreach services. "Homebound" is defined as being confined to one's home due to illness, age, disability or other qualifying circumstance.

No overdue fines will be charged. However, participants are responsible for all items checked out to them.

Materials available through outreach include all materials that would be circulated through normal library practices.

Participants are required to sign the Outreach Policy accepting responsibility for the proper care of library materials checked out to them. Signers will be issued a library card if they do not already possess one. Library accounts must be in good standing or circulation privileges will be terminated.
